

Worksheet for Developing a Student Improvement Plan

Work either singly or in small groups to answer the following question:

1. List all prevention and intervention strategies already in place at your school, grouping them in the following categories, which correspond to the one's in the pyramid below.
 - a. Strategies for Identified Underachievers (entering ninth-graders)
 - b. Strategies for All Ninth-Graders
 - c. Strategies for Persistent Underachievers
 - d. Strategies for Fewer than 5 Percent of Underachievers
2. Evaluate each strategy carefully to determine whether it fits with your school's philosophical structure (i.e. mission, vision, values, and goals).
 - a. Place check marks beside those that are already philosophically sound and do not need to be changed.
 - b. Place a **C** beside those strategies that will need to be modified to better fit into your school's philosophical structure.
3. Now, looking at your pyramid of interventions as a whole, identify any gaps in the structure that need to be filled (e.g., strategies to support specific subgroups). Add those strategies to your earlier list in question 1, placing an **N** beside them to mark them as new.
